Bradshaw stays hot at the SCGA Junior Championship

Thomas Bradshaw kept the heat on with a second round 70 to lead by three over Sumter's Hayden Letien. His 136 total leaves him at 8 under par for the championship and with a solid lead for the final round. Letien fired the round of the day with a 66, including a double bogey on his last hole. Crawford Reeves and Stephen Behr are four back at 140 heading into the final round. The field was cut to the low 36 and ties which fell on the 153 number to qualify for the final round.

Miller Capps also had a hot day on the course. A hole in one on the 209 yard par 3 17th aided in his 3 under par round 69 for the day. As the leader in the 13-14 bracket, Capps is also eligible for the overall title as he is competing from the same tees as the 15-17 year olds. He has a 3 stroke margin in his bracket and is tied for second overall at 139. The younger bracket was cut to the low 24 and ties for the final round with 166 earning the final round privilege.

The 2008 field consists of 136 competitors from all across SC that have earned their way via four regional qualifiers or were exempt based on 2007-2008 tournament finishes. The Champion will receive an exemption into the SCGA Amateur Championship, the International Junior Four Ball, and the top eight finishers will represent the SCGA in the Georgia-South Carolina Team Matches.

For this year's South Carolina Golf Association's Junior Championship, the competitors with previous experience will notice an enhanced atmosphere. The Heritage Classic Foundation has signed on as presenting sponsor for the South Carolina Championship. This year's contest will make a historical visit back to the Country Club of Lexington, where it was played for 29 years before moving to other sites

around the state of SC. The staff and the membership have been the epitome of southern hospitality for the playing guests of the championship.

The Heritage Classic Foundation is the general sponsor of the Verizon Heritage, the Verizon Junior Heritage and The Players Amateur and has raised more than \$16.6 million for charity since its inception in 1987. The Heritage Classic Foundation has a long history of supporting junior golf programs in SC. They have been the title sponsor of the South Carolina Junior Golf Association Rankings for the past seven years. They have also been a primary sponsor for the only International Junior Four Ball Tournament held at the Savannah Westin Resort - home of the Champions Tour Liberty Mutual Legends of Golf. They also have been a vital part of putting golf in schools through a pilot First Tee program in Beaufort County Schools.
