The SCGA and the USGA are grateful to Daniel Island for hosting this USGA event. Please remember that we are their guests, and our conduct should reflect our thanks. Bobby Donnellan is the Director of Golf , please feel free to call him with any questions about the facility.

The information below will help you in making arrangements for the practice and official rounds.

Non-Metal Spikes: Daniel Island Golf Club does not allow the use of metal or traditional designed spikes. Non-metal spikes are required of all participants.

Caddies: Please be reminded that all players are required to walk in all phases (excluding practice rounds) of the championship. You are responsible for providing your own caddie. Also, clubs **may not** be transported on a golf cart. Both the player and the caddie must walk. Spectator carts will not be available.

The use of an immediate family member as a caddie is **prohibited**.

Practice: Each entrant is entitled to **one practice round** any weekday prior to qualifying, June 26th. Times will be available through the golf shop. Please call 843-971-3542 to arrange for your practice round time.

Food Service: Food service will be available the day of qualifying at 8:00 a.m. in the Ball Room. A lunch buffet will be offered as well for players and spectators. Please note that the Pub is for members only.

Dress Code: Bermuda length shorts are allowed. Golf or collared sport shirts are required. No denim for players or spectators and the use of cell phones in the clubhouse is prohibited.

Lodging: The Sleep Inn is offering a rate of \$89. Call 843-856-5000. Also will be the Comfort Inn with a rate of \$95. Call 843-725-5400. Both Properties are within 10 miles of the course.
