SCGA Junior Championship- Second Round Results

After two days of great play, Stephen Behr has the lead in the SCGA Junior Championship. The Florence native fired consecutive rounds of 68 to lead by two strokes over Easley's Hayden Garrett. Two age brackets are competing over the 6,656 yard Wildcat Course of Fort Jackson Golf Club. Keenan Huskey of Greenville has the overnight lead after a two day total of 147 in the younger boys 13-14 division. He has a one stroke lead over Austin Zoller and Trace Crowe. The boys 13-14 bracket was cut to the low 14 players and ties, while the 15-17 division has 49 players that made the cut.

Three qualifying sites hosted non exempt players trying to earn their way into the event. Wyboo Golf Club in Manning, Columbia CC, and Hickory Knob State Park in McCormick were all gracious hosts to the players in early May. The competitors ranged in age from 15-17. The three sites were open to a total of 115 players vying for 69 coveted spots into the Championship.
