SCGA Junior Championship - First Round Results

The opening round of the 53rd SCGA Junior Championship presented by the Heritage Classic Foundation greeted players with great weather and facility conditions at Oldfield Club in Okatie, SC. Players were even treated with a visit by the Inaugural Champion, Thad Vincent who won the first two SCGA Junior Championships. The 2009 US Open Champion and former winner of this title, Lucas Glover, presented the field with autographed Heritage Classic Foundation hats as part of the player gift packets.

Two players sit atop the leader board at four under par 68. Austin Langdale (Townville) and Will Starke (Chapin) both shot two under on the front and back nines respectively. One stroke back sits 2011 Junior Heritage Champion, Matthew Nesmith (N. Augusta) at 69. All three players represent the 15-17 age bracket.

In the younger, 13-14 age bracket, Keenan Huskey (Greenville) leads by one shot over Cole Patterson (Greenville) after he finished the day at even par 72. One lone birdie on his front side offset the backside bogey to keep him at level par.

After two rounds, the field will be cut to the low 66 and ties. Both age brackets; 13-14, and 15-17, played the course at a par of 72 and yardage of 6,865. The top eight finishers overall will be selected to represent SC in the 36th Annual Georgia-SC Team matches to be contested at the nearby May River Golf Club at Palmetto Bluff.

For the fourth consecutive year The Heritage Classic Foundation has signed on as presenting sponsor of the South Carolina Junior Championship to continue their strong support of junior programs in SC. The Heritage Classic Foundation is the general sponsor of The Heritage, the Junior Heritage and The Players Amateur and has raised close to \$20 million for charity since its inception in 1987. The Heritage Classic Foundation has a long history of supporting junior golf programs in SC. They have been the title sponsor of the South Carolina Junior Golf Association Rankings for the past 10 years.

Oldfield Golf Club has a treasured history in the low country. “We dream of getting a site like this one,” noted Greg Norman, when asked about Oldfield, “and since this is our first course in the Lowcountry, we want to make it something special.” Noted for designing courses in concert with their natural environment, Greg Norman created one of his finest golf courses at Oldfield; by crafting an outstanding route through canopies of moss draped live oaks, broad savannahs, and soaring pines up to the banks of the Okatie River. With five sets of tees, the course is as playable as it is beautiful. Among Oldfield’s most prized accolades for stewardship was an honor bestowed by Audubon International. Thanks to careful design and a continued commitment to preservation, Oldfield’s course was named a Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary in recognition of its “environmental planning, wildlife and habitat management, chemical reduction and safety, water conservation and water quality management.”
