

16th Annual South Carolina Golf Association Harry Wilson Super Senior Championship

ENTRY FEE: \$150 PER PERSON

Eligibility

Open to 2023 male members of the SCGA who are residents of South Carolina. Players must be at least 65 years of age as of October 17, 2023. Entries may be declined for those individuals who have not had reasonable activity on their club's handicap roster as of the most recent update.

Entries

Entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on October 4, 2023. Field will be limited to 88 players. Priorities are as follows: (1) First come, first serve based on Date and Time of Entry. Players tournament record and past SCGA performance may also be considered. Acceptance will be posted online at www.scgolf.org.

Format

USGA rules apply, 36-hole stroke play to determine Champion. The field will play in two different divisions, the Championship Division and the Legends Division. Players must be 70 years of age and older to be eligible for the Legends Division. The overall Champion will come from the Championship Divisions & Awards will be for gross score only.

Practice Rounds

Upon notification of acceptance, each individual will be entitled to 1 practice round for \$35 (players responsible to pay the golf shop). Call the Golf Shop to make arrangements at (843) 669-3554. Times available October 17th and earlier based on space available basis. Reservations Required.

Carts

Carts fees for the tournament are paid for by the SCGA. Players are responsible for a \$35 cart fee for the Practice Round to Florence Country Club.
