

SCGA Forty Plus Series Finale Long Bay Golf Club Longs, SC December 6-7, 2025

Entry Fee - \$400 Per Team

Optional \$80 Team Skins Buy in (\$40 Per Day Buy In) – Pot will be split 60% to the skins game and 40% to the SCJGF

In an effort to offer a higher level of competition for all players, the SCGA conducts a series of One Day events called the Forty Plus Series. True to its name, these events are geared towards the "Generation X"group, players between the ages of 40 and 54. Forty Plus events are championships conducted as one day tournaments and are generally played on Mondays with the Finale being on a Sunday-Monday. Entry fees include cart, lunch, gross and net prizes.

The 40 Plus Series Finale will offer a Tournament Division for players 40 - 54 and a Senior Division for players 55 - 64 years of age. A super-senior division will be offered, if more than 8 teams meet those expectations signup (65+). Divisions will be based off the younger players age in the pair.

Eligibility

Open to 2025 male members of the SCGA who are over the age of 40* as of December 6, 2025. Participants must have a current SCGA handicap index not exceeding 15.6. Received applications may be returned to those teams that have not had reasonable activity on their club's handicap roster as of the most recent update.

Entries

Entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on November 27, 2025. **Field will be limited to 50 teams. Priorities are as follows: First Come – First Served based on date of entry and time received. Acceptance will be posted online at www.scgolf.org.

Format

USGA rules apply, 36-hole Four-Ball stroke play. Gift certificates will be awarded to the low gross and net scores. The emphasis will be toward the gross awards.

Schedule

December 5 Designated Practice Round at a rate of \$65 (Dec 1-5) – Practice round tee times on a space available basis and can be made beginning November 19th.

December 6 First round. 10:00 AM SHOTGUN start. December 7 Final round, awards, & lunch served after play. 9:30 AM SHOTGUN start.
