

SCGA Senior Championship Woodside Country Club – Jones Course June 4-6, 2025

Entry Fee: \$250 per player

Eligibility

Open to 2025 male members of the SCGA who are residents of South Carolina. Participants must be at least 55 years of age as of June 4, 2025. Entries may be declined for those individuals who have not had reasonable activity on their club's handicap roster as of the most recent update.

Entries

Entrants must have a current handicap index of 10.4 or less. Entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on April 17, 2024. The field will be limited to 120 individuals. The 110 entries with the lowest handicap indexes will be accepted as of the April 4th update. Player's tournament record and past SCGA performance may also be considered. The host club will receive three (3) exemptions and an additional seven (7) spots will be awarded to remaining entrants during a qualifying round, should it be necessary. The qualifier will be held in conjunction with the practice round held June 3rd at Woodside CC. Acceptance will be posted by May 22nd.

Format

USGA rules apply, 54-hole stroke play to determine a Champion. The field will be cut to the low 60 plus ties after the second round. This number may be adjusted based on the size of the starting field. **Please note, there is no Super Sr. Division**

Schedule

June 3rd and Prior One Practice Round available on a space available basis. Players may begin calling to book practice rounds on May 15th.Tee times should be made through the Woodside golf shop at (803) 649-3383.

June 4 & 5 First and Second Rounds (Double Tee Double Wave Start) – 36-hole cut. Player lunch served both days.

June 6 Final round and awards

Carts

Tournament Cart Fees are paid by the SCGA. All players are required to ride during the event. A \$50 fee is due to the club when playing a practice round.

Refund

A \$30.00 administration fee will be charged for all refunds until May 26th. No refunds after May 26th.

The SCGA reserves the right to refuse entry into any event based on behavior that may affect the integrity of our Association. Players are required to adhere to the dress code of the facility and conduct themselves in the manner of keeping with the highest standards of the SCGA. Players refusing to comply will be disqualified from the competition.
