



2026 MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Tournament Host: South Carolina Golf Association

Host Facility: Callawassie Island Club

This Memorandum of Agreement is entered by and between the tournament host (South Carolina Golf Association “SCGA”) and host facility (Florence Country Club “Host Course”). The parties agree to the following facts and information:

Title of Competition and Dates: 68th SCGA Senior Championship; WEEK OF MAY 3-8, 2026. Days of the week are very flexible

Size of Field: Maximum starting field of 132 players with a cut to the low 60 players and ties after the second round. If an event does not fill, the SCGA will provide a final player count approximately one week prior to the competition.

Format: 54-Holes of Stroke Play. The field will be cut to the low 60 players and ties after the second round.

Playoffs: By sudden death, only if there is a tie for the Championship.

Cart Fee: \$35 per player, per day will be included in the overall course fee paid to the host course. The host course agrees to provide approximately TBD complimentary carts for the SCGA staff and Rules Committee.

Food & Beverage: The Host Course will retain all food and beverage revenue. Please denote what method of payments are acceptable. Cash and Credit Card accepted.

Prizes: For a full field, approximately \$4,000 in the form of pro shop gift certificates. If the event does not sell out, prize money will be calculated based on the field size percentage. All gift certificates must be valid until December 31, 2025, or through clubs closing date for 2025.

Practice Rounds: Players may make arrangements for practice rounds on a space available basis. The Host Course is required to provide a window of opportunity for players to practice. For practice rounds: green fees, range balls and carts are the responsibility of the player at the championship specific fee agreed upon by the Host Course and the SCGA.

Practice Round Fee: ____\$40-\$60____

Date/Time Availability and Restrictions: **May TBD and prior based on course availability. Players will book directly through the Callawassie Golf Shop.**

Access: Players will have access to the clubhouse and grounds during practice rounds and the Championship.

Playing Conditions: The Host Course and SCGA agree to cooperate in determining the playing conditions of the golf course. In the event a day of competition is canceled or delayed due to acts of nature, the SCGA and the Host Course agree to resume, reschedule, or cancel the competition as soon as mutually agreed to by both parties. A round will not be declared weathered out unless the Course Superintendent declares the golf course unplayable. The tournament will not be extended an extra day unless agreed to by the Host Course and the SCGA.

Obligations of the SCGA: The SCGA agrees, at its expense, to do the following: Advertise, accept and process entries for, and conduct the competition. Provide official scorecards and score sheets and supervise scoring. Provide a course marking team to paint and mark specific areas on the golf course, such as penalty areas, ground under repair, etc., prior to the Championship. Consult regularly with Host Course officials on all aspects of the Championship.

Obligations of the Host Course: The Host Course agrees, at its expense, to do the following: Provide the golf course, facilities, and equipment for the Championship. Prepare the golf course in accordance with recommendations mutually agreed to by the Host Course and the SCGA. Provide a scoreboard or scoring area where score sheets can be posted if so needed.

Course Evacuation/Lightning Protection. The SCGA reserves the right to suspend play, and will be the sole judge of this, at any time during the competition for weather/dangerous situations. The SCGA will coordinate the evacuation with the Host Course to include both tournament and non-tournament players. The SCGA subscribes to Perry Weather for weather forecasting and will use this service to assist in forecasting and implementing suspensions in play as needed.
